

What you get for your money – update 2014

MADAGASCAR

£ 50 will cover the cost of one training session for anti-AIDS clubs in 15 different schools (£ 3.3 per school) (tweeted 26/02/15)

£ 170 to purchase 5,000 condoms for free distribution (£ 0.03 per condom)

£ 508 will cover the cost for distribution of 500 STI testing vouchers (£ 1 per voucher)

£ 678 will cover the cost for distribution of 400 STI treatment vouchers (£1.7 per voucher)

MALAWI

€ 408 will cover the cost to establish 6 radio listening clubs to disseminate accurate HIV/AIDS information among youths (€ 68 per club)

€ 91 will cover the cost to provide radio orientation to 3 peer educators (€ 30.6 per person)

€ 614 will cover the cost of broadcasting 12 radio sessions (€ 51 each)

DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

£ 8,091 will cover the cost of sex and relationships education training for 60 church leaders for two weeks to impact up to 20,000 children (£ 135 per leader)

SOUTH SUDAN

£ 1,500 will cover the cost to provide vocational skills and life skills education to 20 street and slum young people and commercial sex workers for one year (£ 75 per person)

KENYA

£ 1,800 will cover one week training for 20 local community organisations' representatives on improving the quality of services to children affected by HIV/AIDS in deprived areas of Kenya. (£ 90 per person)

UGANDA

£ 1,730 will cover the cost of training 96 deaf young people in HIV/AIDS and sexual reproductive health (£ 18 per person)

€ 882 will cover the cost to educate 250 HIV infected adolescents on ART and provide psycho-social support and life skills. (€3.5 per adolescent)

€ 614 will cover the cost to train and provide income generating activities to 250 adolescent girls (€ 2.45 per girl) (Tweeted 27/02/15)

£ 1,000 will cover the cost to train 50 youth peer educators in sexual reproductive health and PMTC including meals & transport (£ 20 per peer educator)

INDIA

£ 612 will cover the cost of 10 HIV/AIDS awareness camps targeting 6,000 teenagers (£ 61,2 per camp, £ 0,1 per teenager)

£ 765 will cover the cost to organize 5 one-day cultural events in 10 junior college and 5 degree and professional colleges (£ 153 per event, £ 10.20 per college)

£ 100 will cover the cost to deliver HIV/AIDS education programmes in 20 villages (£ 5 per village)

£ 315 will cover the cost to train 105 adolescent peer educators for three days (£ 3 per person)

£ 625 will cover the cost to organize 50 HIV mass awareness rallies in remote villages (£ 12.5 per rally)

£ 1,250 will cover the cost to organize elocution & essay writing competitions on HIV/AIDS with prizes in 50 different schools (£ 25 per school)

£ 51 will cover the cost to form 5 women groups to deliver HIV/AIDS/STIs sensitization among adolescent girls (£ 10.20 per group)

BANGLADESH

£ 1,120 will cover the cost to provide meals to 1,600 transport workers attending HIV/AIDS training (£ 0.70 per person)

GHANA

£ 105.60 will cover the cost to provide lunch for 3 days to 44 participants attending capacity building for peer leaders workshop (£ 0.8 per person/per day)

£ 69.5 will cover the cost of training materials (flipchart, markers, photocopies)

£ 332 will cover the cost to provide resource materials to deliver skills training to 200 participants (£1.65 per person)

TANZANIA

£ 3,870 will cover the cost of health club activities, training and workshops in 14 schools for one year (£ 276.40 per school / £ 23 per month)(£ 276.40 per school / £ 23 per month)
